Tahón de Tobelos is an extraordinary blend of Viura and selection of minor local authorized grapes varieties of Rioja from our “Jardin de las Variedades” (the “garden”) plot. A wine with promising future!

<b>GRAPES</b>	85 % Viura & 15 % of minor white grape varieties (Tempranillo blanco, Garnacha blanca, Verdejo, Turruntés, Maturana Blanca, Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, Malvasia).
<b>WINEMAKING</b>	Cooling of grapes for 24 hours in a cold chamber. Manual assortment table. Alcoholic fermentation in two 1,000 liter stainless steel tanks.
<b>AGEING</b>	16 months aging with its own lees with <i>batonnage</i> in 225L French oak casks, followed by 24 months aging in bottle.
<b>SERVICE</b>	Between 9°C and 11°C.
<b>COLOUR</b>	Brilliant lemon yellow color.
<b>NOSE</b>	Intense bouquet of aromas, combining fruit and tertiary aromas. Very complex nose: pear, apple, apricot, vanilla, anise, cinnamon, hazelnut and spice registers; that clearly reflects its identity.
<b>MOUTH</b>	Firm and fresh attack, great complexity and volume. Perfectly balanced, from start to finish; unctuous integrating fruit and notes from the barrel ageing process.

This wine is created from a special selection of plots at the foot of the Sierra Cantabria Mountain and higher course of the Ebro River situated in different locations: Labastida and Briñas situated at 550 - 528- 450 m. asl respectively. Poor, clayey calcareous soils on terraces that give rise to bush vines with an extraordinary character.

In general, 2020 was a cool and rainy year. It started with a very early bud break and the numerous spring rains resulted in fungal diseases (especially mildew) that impacted the harvest heavily. Beyond this, there were the obvious complications from the COVID-19 pandemic, which above all else, qualifies this year as "historic." After a warm summer, the moderate temperatures in September gave rise to a very balanced character to the wine, with ideal alcohol content, great aromatic intensity and excellent freshness. 2020 was a year with optimal sanitary conditions.
